SOLAR SYSTEM AND PLANETS

The universe and our planet...

The question that crosses everyone's mind: Are we alone in the universe or not? Since its existence, humankind has looked at the sky, the stars, the sun, the moon, the satellite of our world, and the morning star, and thought: Are we alone in the universe or not? I was very curious about this, like everyone else; Were we alone in the universe or not?

The distance of the planets from the sun determines the length of their year. Our planet completes one revolution around the Sun in 365 days and six hours, and each tour is called a year. For Mercury, the closest planet to the Sun, this period is eighty-eight Earth days. That is, if we lived on Mercury, we would have lived a year in eighty-eight days. On Neptune, the farthest planet from the Sun, this period is approximately 165 years, and if we lived on Neptune, we would all die before reaching the age of one. So, are we alone in the universe? While we discover new lives and new species every day, even on our own planet, it would not be a dream to think of life on other planets. Although no scientist or spaceport has yet found whether there is life on a planet other than Earth, there may be another planet at the same distance from us, but why might we not notice this planet? On a dark night, when a

car is approaching you with its high beams on, can you see the firefly behind the car? It will not be possible to see the firefly as the headlights of the car will dazzle your eyes. When we think about this scientific phenomenon, the existence of another planet that is the same distance from the sun as our earth is scientifically possible, but it is not possible to see this planet except through a satellite sent outside the solar system. Gravity is the Saniye factor that affects all living things on the planet. The third factor that will affect the life of living things is the atmosphere. For example, it is known that dinosaurs became extinct as a result of a meteorite hitting the Earth sixty-five million years ago, but dinosaurs did not become extinct because of this, but rather due to lack of oxygen as a result of the gas and dust cloud covering the entire atmosphere.

THE BIRTH OF UMUT AND SANIYE

At that moment, a meteorite begins to fall from the sky, burning as it enters the earth's atmosphere, and they all see this and get excited. After the meteor slips and falls, scattering lights, Umut excitedly asks his father what it is, and his father says that it is a meteorite. Ms.

Ayşe tells her children that it is time to sleep and takes them to bed. Umut immediately falls asleep and in his dream he is on a star, holding a toy radio made from a matchbox made by his father. Saniye stands on another star. Umut talks to his sister until the morning with the walkie-talkie his father made from a matchbox. In the morning, Ms. Ayşe wakes up Umut and Saniye by stroking their hair, and they have breakfast as a family. Umut and Saniye play with their matchbox phones all day long.

Umut is in the 5th grade of primary school. He has never forgotten the wireless phone his father made from a matchbox for him and his brother to play with when he was only 5 years old. His teacher told Umut that scientists around the world have been doing research on this subject, but they have not yet found a world or planet where creatures like us live.
